## SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

## VILLAGE OF WAVERLY WAVERLY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

## -Residents-

A Snow Emergency exists in the Village of Waverly, when snow falls in any 24-hour period to depth of 4 inches or more, or when roadway conditions are extremely hazardous.

Parked cars present the greatest obstacle to the Village Street Department in snow removal operations.

## -Streets-

When a snow emergency is declared, it shall be unlawful for anyone to park any vehicle for periods longer than 3 minutes during the hours of 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. on any street in the Village.

Such an emergency will continue for 24 hours.
Violation of any provision of the ordinance may result in a fine of up to $\$ 100.00 \mathrm{and} /$ or imprisonment for a maximum of 15 days for each separate offense.
-Sidewalks-

1) Snow and ice on sidewalks are hazardous to all pedestrians.

Your cooperation is essential. Safety is the primary concern.
2) It is the responsibility of each property owner in the Village, to clean, or cause to be cleaned, of snow and ice, public sidewalks fronting their property, within 24 hours after the end of a snowfall. Walks of all commercial establishments must be kept free of ice and snow between the hours of 9 a.m. \& 5 p.m. If snow and ice are not removed within the specified time frame, the Village is empowered to implement removal and bill the property owner.
3) Violators will receive snow removal (or treatment) service and bills for same, calculated at the rate of $\mathbf{1 5}$ cents per sq. ft., plus $\mathbf{\$ 2 5}$ administrative fee. All bills remaining unpaid will be added to property taxes.
